

**ORDINANCE NO. 159**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING  
TRAFFIC ON THE Y BRIDGE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Galena wishes to keep its property safe and keep citizens from harm and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Galena wishes to maintain the Y Bridge, its most notable landmark,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that any traffic on the Y Bridge other than pedestrian traffic shall be prohibited. Forms of prohibited traffic shall include, but shall not be limited to: automobiles, go-carts, all-terrain vehicles, snowmobiles, motorcycles and other motorized vehicles.

Any person in violation of any provision of this ordinance on conviction shall pay a fine not less than \$50.00 or more than \$500.00 or be confined to jail for a period not to exceed 90 days, or both such fine and confinement may be imposed.
